## Selected Relevant Information for Waters Edge Residents

### **Payment for Garbage Pickup**

Garbage fees are included in your water bill. For normal weekly service, a fee of \$32.10 should appear on your bill to cover the costs of garbage pickup.

### **Curbside Pickup Includes:**

#### **Trash**

Household garbage must be placed in suitable bags, securely tied at the top with no tears or leaks (use more bags instead of overfilling). Bags need to be placed into a clean, City-issued garbage can. Bags left outside the container (such as on top of the lid or on the ground) will not be collected.

Garbage cans must be placed curbside at the street, 3 feet from any object, not blocking pedestrian or vehicular traffic and **in front of the property from which the waste originated**. Garbage cans must be located outside fences and other enclosed areas.

#### **Recycling**

On your collection day, please place your recycling bin at the curb by 6:30 a.m., rain or shine. If you've accidentally discarded something that cannot be recycled, we'll leave it in your bin. The following items are acceptable for recycling:

- Aluminum cans and tin cans
- Paper (newspapers or magazines)
- Flattened cardboard boxes
- Plastic (No. 1 and No. 2)

#### **Other residential debris**

**February through September** - Grass trimmings and small shrubbery trimmings must be placed in plastic bags or other suitable containers along with bagged leaves

**October through January** - unbagged leaves will be picked up by City vacuum trucks.

Limbs and cuttings must not exceed **5 feet in length** or **50 pounds in weight**. Limbs and cuttings must be kept separate and not exceed 1 cubic yard per week.

Volumes that exceed the above limits may result in additional fees added to a resident's water bill.

- Gould Lane Compactor Site, 1277 Hillside Gardens Lane, Gainesville, GA 30504 (no cost for Hall County residents) - bagged garbage, debris, motor oil, and recyclables (including glass)
- Hall County Landfill, 1700 Oakbrook Drive, Gainesville, GA 30507
- Arrange for a trash pick-up contractor or other contractor to pick up and dispose of larger items

## **The City will NOT Collect the following**

### **Glass items**

#### **Building materials such as:**

- Landscape timbers
- Discarded construction material
- Dirt
- Rocks
- Bricks
- Debris from move-ins/move-outs

#### **Remodeling or construction waste such as:**

- Plumbing fixtures
- Sinks
- Tubs
- Shower stalls
- Toilets
- Cabinets
- Doors
- Windows
- Roofing debris
- Lumber
- Siding
- Carpet
- Carpet padding
- Floor coverings
- Waste requiring special disposal including:
  - Rubber tires
  - Automotive parts
  - Acid
  - Flammable liquids
  - Dangerous or corrosive materials
  - Hazardous or bio-medical waste

### **Other**

The City WILL pick up the following items **for a fee**:

Large appliances, Washers, Microwaves, Stoves, Refrigerators, Air conditioners, Televisions, Computers, Furniture, Mattresses.

**You must call in advance to schedule these collections.**
